

## **Reaside Academy – Pupil Premium Impact Report**

**2021-2022**

### **Key question to be answered:**

How well do Year 6 disadvantaged children perform compared to their non-disadvantaged peers at Reaside and nationally?

### **Context**

203 children were on roll at end of the Summer Term 2021. 76% of children were Pupil Premium

35 out of 46 children (76%) of Year 6 in 2021/22 were disadvantaged.
