

## **Reaside Academy – Pupil Premium Impact Report**

**2022-2023**

### **Key question to be answered:**

How well do Year 6 disadvantaged children perform compared to their non-disadvantaged peers at Reaside and nationally?

### **Context**

203 children were on roll at end of the Summer Term 2023. 72% of children were Pupil Premium

37 out of 58 children (64%) of Year 6 in 2022/23 were disadvantaged.
