There are two School Direct training options:

- The School Direct Tuition Programme is for high-quality graduates who want to feel part of a school team within a family of ECMAT schools. You
 will pay University fees and may be eligible for a bursary (Please check with NCTL for further bursary details)
- The School Direct Salaried Programme is an employment-based route for high-quality experienced graduates with at least three years' work
 experience. You will earn a salary while you train within your chosen school.
