On behalf of Supt Ian Green, Chief Inspector Bailey has asked us to send out the below message to schools for sharing with pupils and parents before the Christmas break:

As part of West Midlands Police's on-going work to tackle knife crime and keep our communities safe, proactive police activity will be taking place in and around bus stops in selected areas of Birmingham over the Christmas period and into the New Year. Police Officers and Police Community Support Officers will engage with members of the community at these locations and this activity may include the use of knife arches and other metal detection equipment to identify weapons possession.
