Reaside Academy CONSTRUCTION OF NEW PRIMARY SCHOOL

ISG Construction have been awarded the contract to construct a new primary school building within the grounds of the existing Reaside Academy.

Work will commence on the new building later this month and will be completed by the Christmas holiday, a period of 43 weeks; following completion of the building they will remain on site for a further 16 weeks to demolish the existing school and remodel the area to provide a grassed playing field, final completion date for all works being late April 2020.

The significant majority of their works will be carried out during the "normal" working week: Monday-Friday, 07.30-17.30; however, where work is required that has a direct interface with the existing school, for the health and safety of pupils, staff and the public these may be carried out during early evening or weekends.

On Saturday 16th and 23rd February they will be carrying out relatively minor tree surgery and tarmac works to the new car park between the hours of 08.00 and 13.00 while the school is closed for half-term to negate risk to staff and pupils
