From 14<sup>th</sup> March we have been using ParentMail. Registering with ParentMail is very easy. You should have received an email and/or a text message from ParentMail with instructions on how to register. Once you have registered, if you have an Android or Apple smartphone, we recommend you download the ParentMail App for the best user experience.

At the moment we are currently just using the text messaging service on ParentMail, however, in the future, we hope to use other services that they offer. I.e. Parent pay, uploading of letters and email service. This is when parents/carers will be able to see the App's full potential!

### Changes to School Meals Price - 1<sup>st</sup> April 2019

Cityserve (our catering providers) have reviewed the position of the charges for school meals for the financial year 2019/2020. In view of the increased costs, they feel it necessary to recommend a price increase per meal for schools. This means that prices from 1st April 2019 will increase from £2.25 per meal to £2.35 per meal. A week will now cost £11.75. Please see a chart below showing bulk prices, for the most popular amount of weeks that parents/carers pay in advance.

| Number of Weeks | Total Amount |
