## Time Capsule event - Thursday 11th April 2019

Representatives from Reaside Academy in Frankley Birmingham, University of Wolverhampton Multi-Academy Trust, Department of Education and main contractor ISG gathered on site to mark the commencement of the project which will provide Reaside with a much-needed new school facility within the existing school site.

To mark this key milestone, children from each class were invited to create pieces to place inside a time capsule. They included poems, pictures, letters to the future and otherschool memorabilia. The time capsule was buried on the new site ready to be uncovered by future generations.

With building works now well underway, the project will provide Reaside Academy with a new, modern school building where all ground floor classrooms will have direct access to shared external play areas. The new school will also serve the wider community with the new school hall being used by community groups.

The school will remain open while works continue and the former building will be demolished once the new school building is occupied.
