We were given a tour around the synagogue and got to see the Torah scrolls rolled out which we were very privileged to be able to see. We also took the opportunity to visit Birmingham Art gallery and museum, visited a section on 'faith in Birmingham' and looked at the Staffordshire Hoard which showed the findings of lots of artefacts from the Anglo-Saxon era.
