One Giant Leap and The Fabulous Four's Time Adventure - Year 5



What a performance! Last term, Year 5 became animators for three days, with the help from professional animator Sophie Burrows. Both classes worked together to create two short movies using the app 'Stop Motion'. The children created their own story, props, characters and settings for their films, as well as recording voice overs. 5E's movie 'One Giant Leap' is a short production set in 1969. Following a dramatic space race with Russia the USA appoints, trains and sends three astronauts to the moon. Will they have enough fuel to land? What will they do when they get there? But most importantly, what will they eat? 5I's movie 'The Fantastic Four go to the Future' is about four young children who are tired of being young and wish to be adults. Adults can do whatever they want, drive cars and stay up late. What's not to love?

On Wednesday, the Year 5 children went to watch a premier of their movies at the local Empire Cinema. There were six other University of Wolverhampton schools there too.
