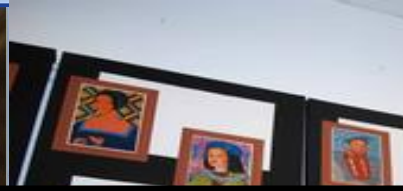

Reaside participates in Teamworx

On Friday 7th June, I went with Ayo, Harley and Ryan from years 5 and 6 to Northfield Community Fire Station. There we took part in the first of a number of Teamworx sessions.

Teamworx is an initiative set up jointly by West Midlands Police & West Midlands Fire and Rescue Service. As part of Teamworx, children aged between eight and ten attend six full day sessions over a six-week period where they learn how to be part of a team and the benefits associated with it.

After meeting with Matt, Ed and Natasha from West Midlands Police, we introduced ourselves to children from other schools in the Frankley and Northfield areas. We also took part in a number of classroom based exercises and, as a team; we came up with our own set of rules for the next six weeks.

In the afternoon we all went into the fire station yard and were given some tricky practical problems to solve. The children had to work as a team but I am delighted to say that all of the Reaside children played a full and active part and also came up with the solution to some of the tasks.

Over the next few weeks we will be taking part in self-defence, horse-riding, football and working with the National Trust. Most importantly, we will be learning how to work as a team.
