At Reaside, we are so very proud of Year 6 as they demonstrated huge amounts of commitment and tried their very best during this challenging test week. This group of Year 6 children have been exceptional in their desire and commitment to do well in their final year at Reaside Academy. We achieved 85% with 45% at greater depth in Reading, 83% with 21% at greater depth in Writing, 79% with 25% at greater depth in Maths and 91% with 51% at greater depth in SPAG....AMAZING!
