Children in Need at Reaside Academy 2019

Since 1980, the BBC's Children in Need charity has been raising money for disadvantaged children, and has become known for its celebrity-filled annual telethon and iconic mascot, Pudsey Bear. Children in Need goes way back to 1927, when the BBC made its first charity appeal via a five-minute radio broadcast.

The first televised appeal, called the Children's Hour, took place in 1955 and was hosted by Harry Corbett and Sooty Bear the yellow glove puppet.

After years of similar appeals, the first Children in Need broadcast took place in 1980 with Terry Wogan as its host. Donations surged thanks to this new format, raising over £1 million on its first attempt.

Last year, it raised £50.5 million and the total across its 40-year history is thought to have topped £1 billion. This year, in addition to the usual glamorous, goofy show, Children in Need has released the album Got it Covered.

The album features a host of stars singing songs that made a big impact on them, from Stevie Wonder's 'I Wish' to Taylor Swift's 'Never Grow Up'. On Friday 15th November, everyone in Reaside 'dressed-up in spots' for the day and raised a massive £231.00.
