Rebuild up-date

We can hardly contain our excitement! On Thursday 9th January, we will have moved into our new school building. Entry into our new school building will revert back to Tresco Close. This marks the end of stage 1 of our re-build programme.

So from Thursday 9th January, we are happy to invite you, once again, to join us for breakfast time from 8.30am.

As before all children must be accompanied by an adult. If you are unable to join us at breakfast time, the school will be open to all children from 8.40am, to ensure all children are ready to be in class, learning by 8.50am.

Stage 2 of the re-build programme begins on Monday 6th January. Whilst in our new school building, we will be able to watch the demolition of our current school building. This will take approximately four months to complete. Over this time, we will also be able to watch the 'massive mud mountain' transformed into a football pitch and our new playground area being created.

During our February half term, we'll continue to improve the interior of our new school building. We are investing in a fantastic library area in the centre of our new school. We'll also be able to continue the development of each of our classrooms, so watch our Twitter feed.

Stage 3 will be the final phase (which is likely to be the end of May). This will be our official opening ceremony, which of course you will be all invited to! We've already started to look for a 'very important person' to cut the ribbon! As soon as we know more, we'll share.
