Advice for Parents - Learning at Home during school closure

We want to make sure that children's learning can continue at home during the potential closure (we are awaiting confirmation from the Trust and the government on developments relating to this). We also want to ensure we give parents advice and guidance on how to achieve this.

As a result, we have adapted (with permission) seven Learning Projects from Robin Hood Multi-Academy Trust for children to complete at home. We will send home a paper copy of these projects and upload the full collection to our school website. These projects have been personalised by school staff to reflect some of the additional resources we have access to online.

Please find links to school-based platforms such as TT Rockstars, IXL or Purple Mash on our school website under Pupils - Learning at Home. Children should have recently brought home their login information for those sites. If you wish for children to complete additional tasks than indicated in the Learning Projects, children can access a range of tasks online on these sites.

We know that many children will have access to the internet at home. Sites like IXL, TTRockstars and Purple Mash will share information with staff about whether children are accessing them. If it appears that no activities are being completed, teachers will inform the Senior Leadership Team and contact will be made via a telephone call to parents.
