

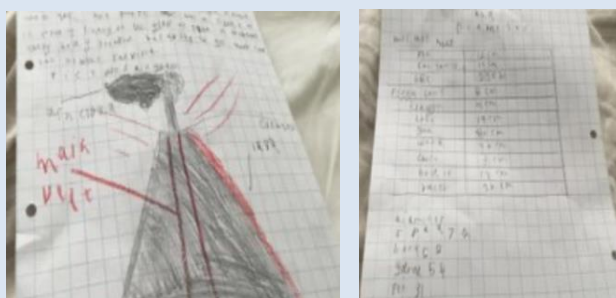


## The Reaside Way: Communication - Pride - Respect

Tyler L in Year 3 has been missing his guitar lessons at school, therefore he has been enjoying practising at home.

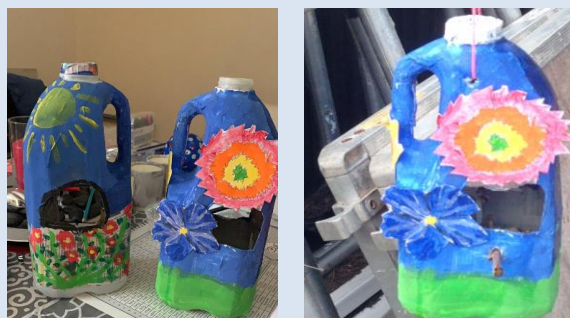


As part of Year 3's Theme topic, Joel G has created a poem and story about a Volcano along with a drawing. As part of Maths, Joel has also been busy with measurement work.
