Michael S in 6B has spent time this week creating a fairy garden made from a plant pot. It looks fantastic!



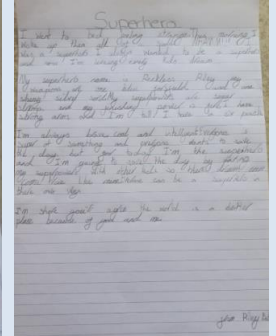
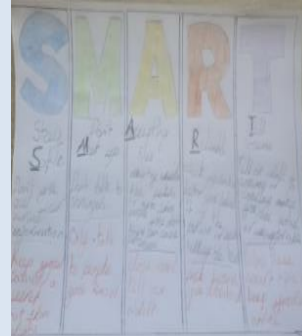
Maka M in 30'L has taken time to create a beautiful art piece this week and has also been

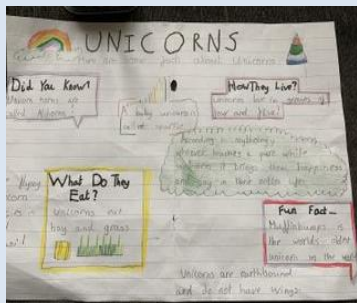

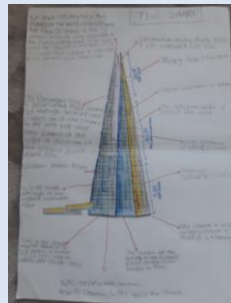
