Harrison B, 5W researched Asiatic Lions this week and their paw prints. He then drew them himself.




Evie F, 5S has spent time baking muffins this week.




Olivia B, 3D has been making some ice-cream cone cookies, completed a factfile all about pandas and has been drawing chalk rainbows to support the NHS.




Charlie W, 3D has been gardening this week.
