All money **MUST** be paid upfront on Monday morning's when a member of the office will be at the school car gate. No money should be handed in other than on a Monday to a member of the office team, Mrs Liggett or Miss Jeffries. Tuck money must also be paid upfront each Monday up until half term and by no later than W/C 05.10.2020. In light of the current circumstances, we **CANNOT** accept daily/weekly amounts of tuck money. We also ask that tuck money is not yet paid for next half term. We will accept payments for the current term only.

MEDICATION

YEAR 4 FOREST SCHOOL

Year 4 children have Forest School every Tuesday. Children will be indoors and outdoors during the school day. Children **MUST** attend school in comfortable, old clothing and sensible coat/footwear weather permitting. Children **DO NOT** need to attend in their school uniform on this day. Your child will need to bring in a spare pair of shoes/trainers to wear in the classroom. Thank you.



HAVING TO CLOSE A CLASS FOLLOWING A POSITIVE TEST:

In the event of closing a class, year group or even whole school closure due to a positive COVID result from a member of the class or staff, the plans for learning at home would be as follows:

- Online learning will be accessed through Dojo. Children will have **their own log-in** details and work will be set by their class teacher. There will be an activity/task set for English and Maths each day along with an 'other' task which will link to the wider curriculum.
- For children who do not have access to a device or the internet, workbooks will be provided with an English and Maths focus.

A CHILD NEEDING TO SELF-ISOLATE FOR 14 DAYS (OR UNTIL THEY GET TEST RESULTS):

- Dojo will be used to set online activities to be completed at home - children will have their own log-in.
- For children who do not have access to a device or the internet work will be posted home. Please bear in mind this will take a couple of days to arrive.

HOW MUCH WORK SHOULD MY CHILD DO A DAY?

- This will vary from child to child and family circumstances. Due to the more intense nature of home learning it is recommended that 3 hours is the maximum per day. Do what is manageable for you as a family.
- You can do other things not set out by the class teacher, reading books, writing stories, painting, drawing, cooking, exercising and anything else that gives opportunities for children to learn.
- If your child is unwell they are not expected to complete work at home.
