Changes in and around school premises from 5th October

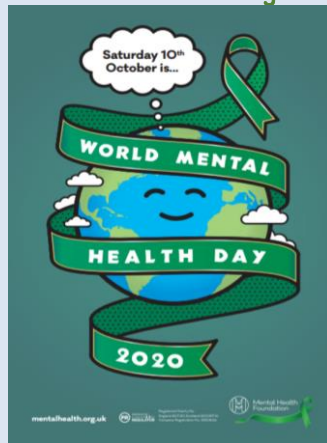
