- It is not advised to spent time talking and socialising with other families on the pavements around the school before and after school

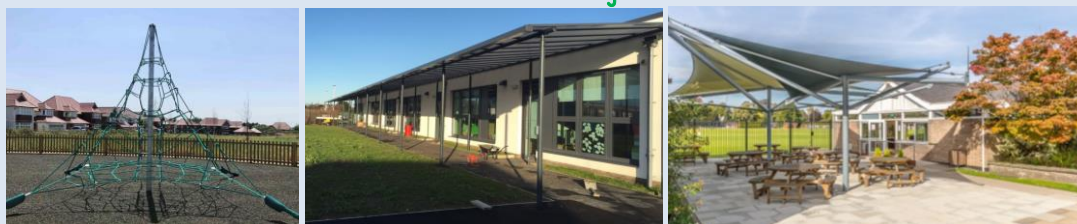


3E Activities
