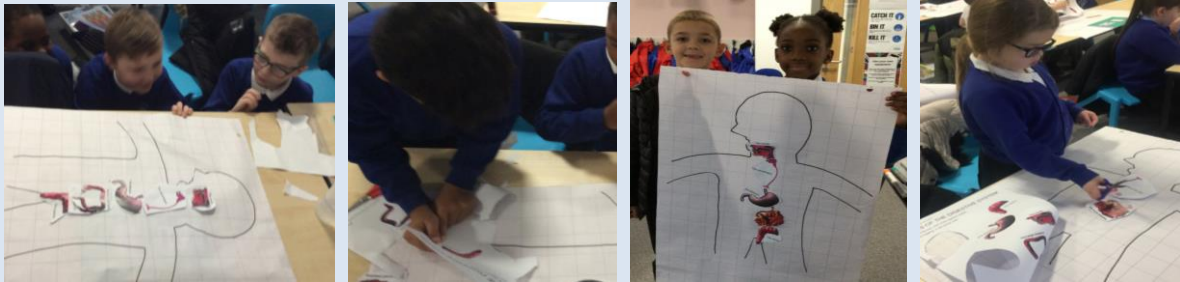


Marvellous Mixtures - 5F

Year 4 Science - Digestive System



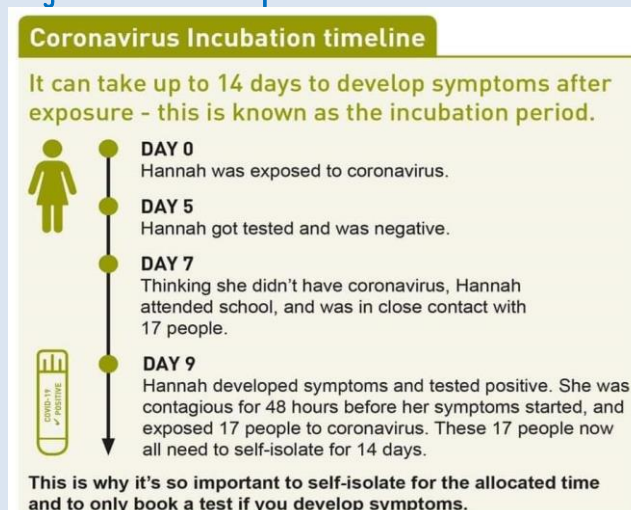
