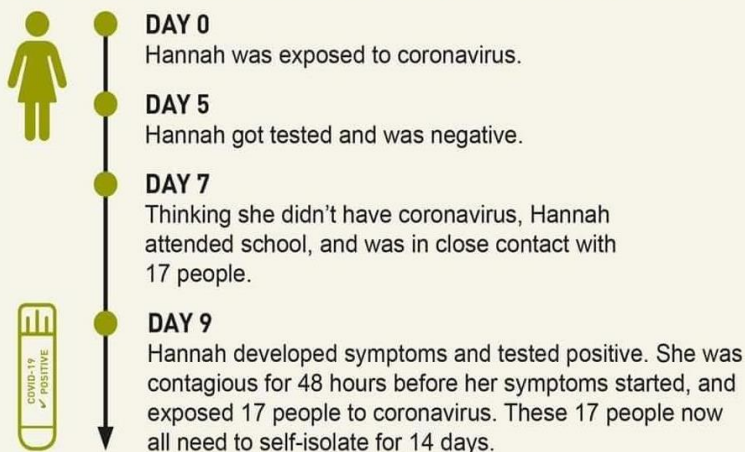
Parent Emails

This is why it's so important to self-isolate for the allocated time and to only book a test if you develop symptoms.

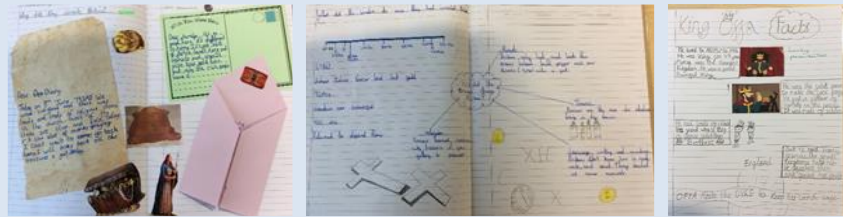

5W also spent time browsing the book fair, socially distanced and without touching the books.

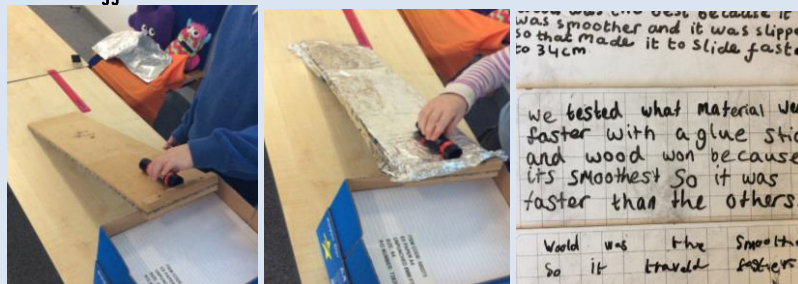
Year 4 Forest School
