School re-opens to key worker and vulnerable children only on Monday 22nd February.

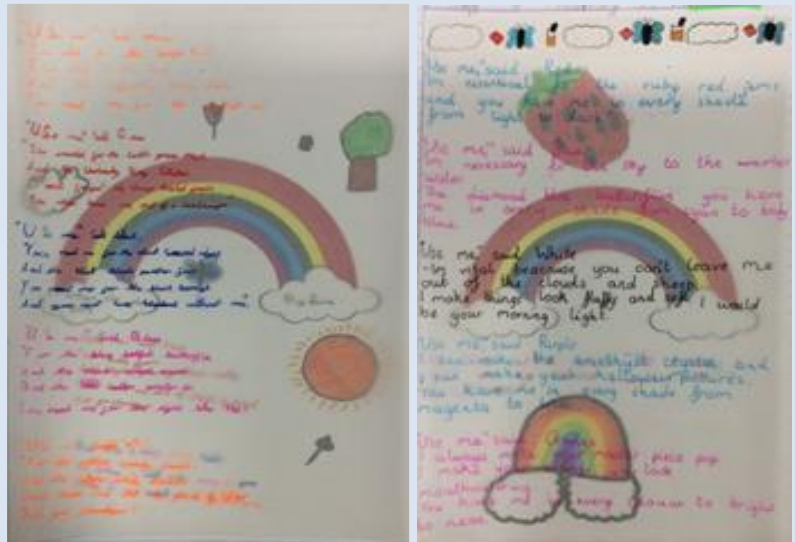

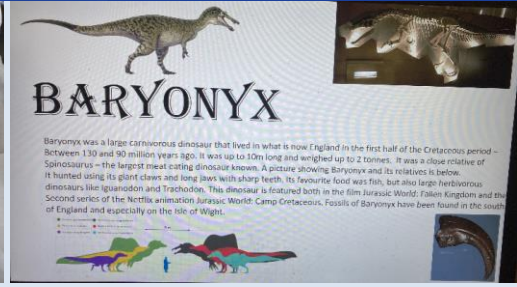
The Reaside Way:

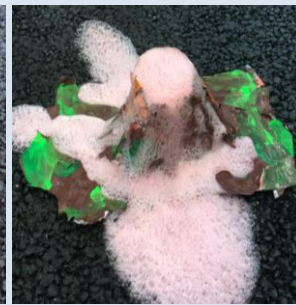
