This week, Year 3 had a go at printing! We created designs based on our science topic- plants. We then made our own printing tiles- we had so much fun, and they turned out amazing!



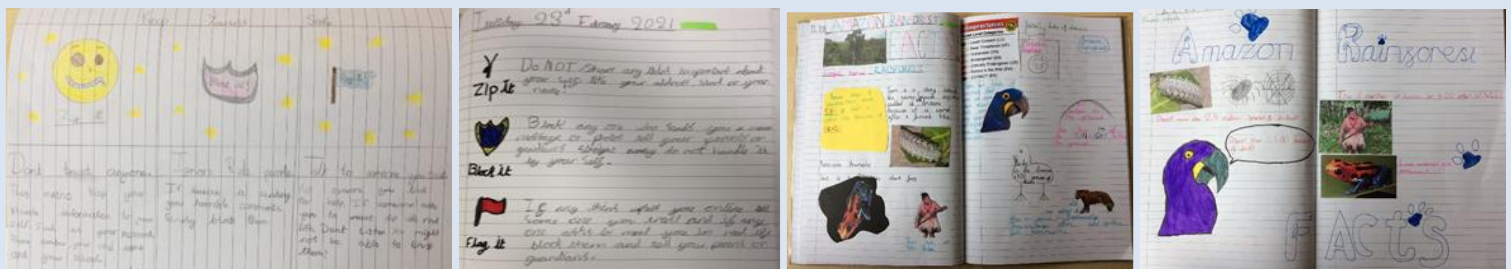
Here are some nature photos from Wednesday's Academy activities! They look great.
