Reporting your child's absence

IMPORTANT REMINDER - ARRIVAL TIMES

Year 5 & 6 children should arrive at school between 8.40 and 8.50am. Year 3 & 4 children should arrive between 8.50 and 9am. If your child is in Year 3 & 4, please DO NOT arrive any earlier than 8.50am. Staggered timings have been put into place to keep children, parents/carers and staff safe. If you do arrive a minute or two earlier, we ask that Year 3 & 4 wait on the opposite side of the road to allow Year 5 & 6 to come through safely without any congestion. Thank you

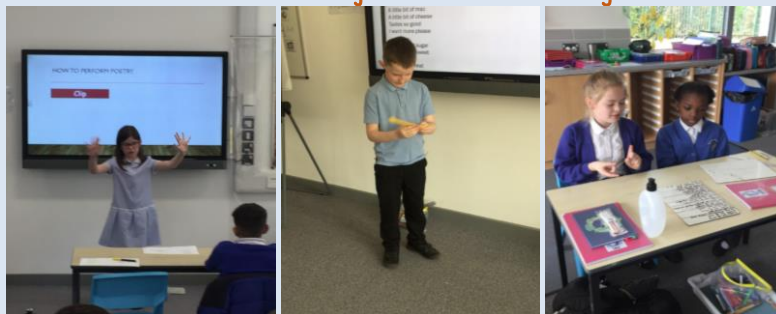


Our new 'Space Net'



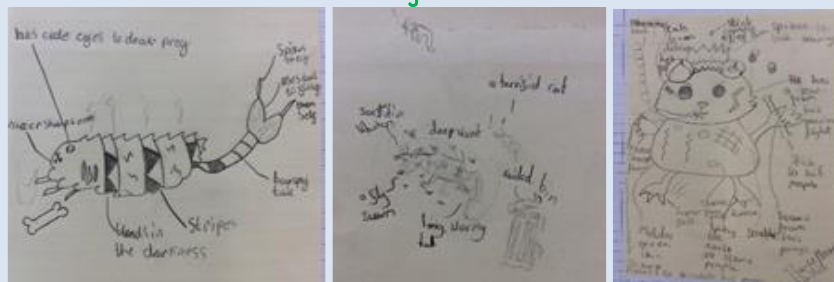
3E were lucky enough to be the first class to try out our new playground equipment this week. We have been having lots of fun playing on it during break and lunchtimes!
