IMPORTANT REMINDER - ARRIVAL TIMES

If your child is in Year 3 & 4, please DO NOT arrive any earlier than 8.50am. Staggered timings have been put into place to keep children, parents/carers and staff safe. 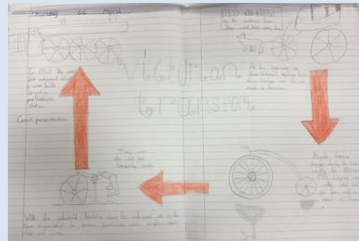
Year 3 Cave paintings

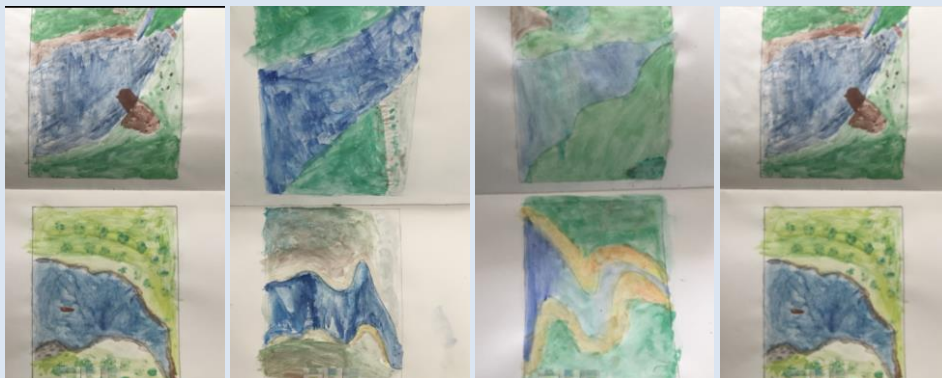
Year 5 Science & Theme
