Reporting your child's absence

IMPORTANT REMINDER - ARRIVAL TIMES

Year 5 & 6 children should arrive at school between 8.40 and 8.50am. Year 3 & 4 children should arrive between 8.50 and 9am. If your child is in Year 3 & 4, please DO NOT arrive any earlier than 8.50am. Staggered timings have been put into place to keep children, parents/carers and staff safe. If you do arrive a minute or two earlier, we ask that Year 3 & 4 wait on the opposite side of the road to allow Year 5 & 6 to come through safely without any congestion. Thank you
