Welcome Mrs Carrier and Mr Parslow

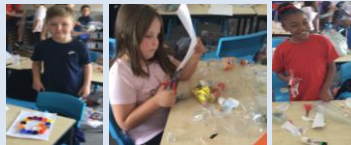

Year 4



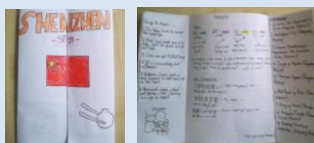

Year 5



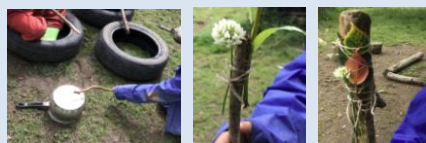
Year 5 had their last session with Commando Joe's this week. As their final treat, they toasted marshmallows.
