Reminders

Attendance/Late arrivals: Parents/Carers must report children's absences to the school office first thing. The office opens from 8am. If the office are receiving a high volume of calls or you call before the office opening time, an answerphone message can be left to report your child's absence. If we do not have a reason for your child's absence, this will be marked as unauthorised on the register. This could then result in you receiving a penalty notice and a criminal record for your child's persistent absence over a period of time.
