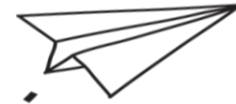

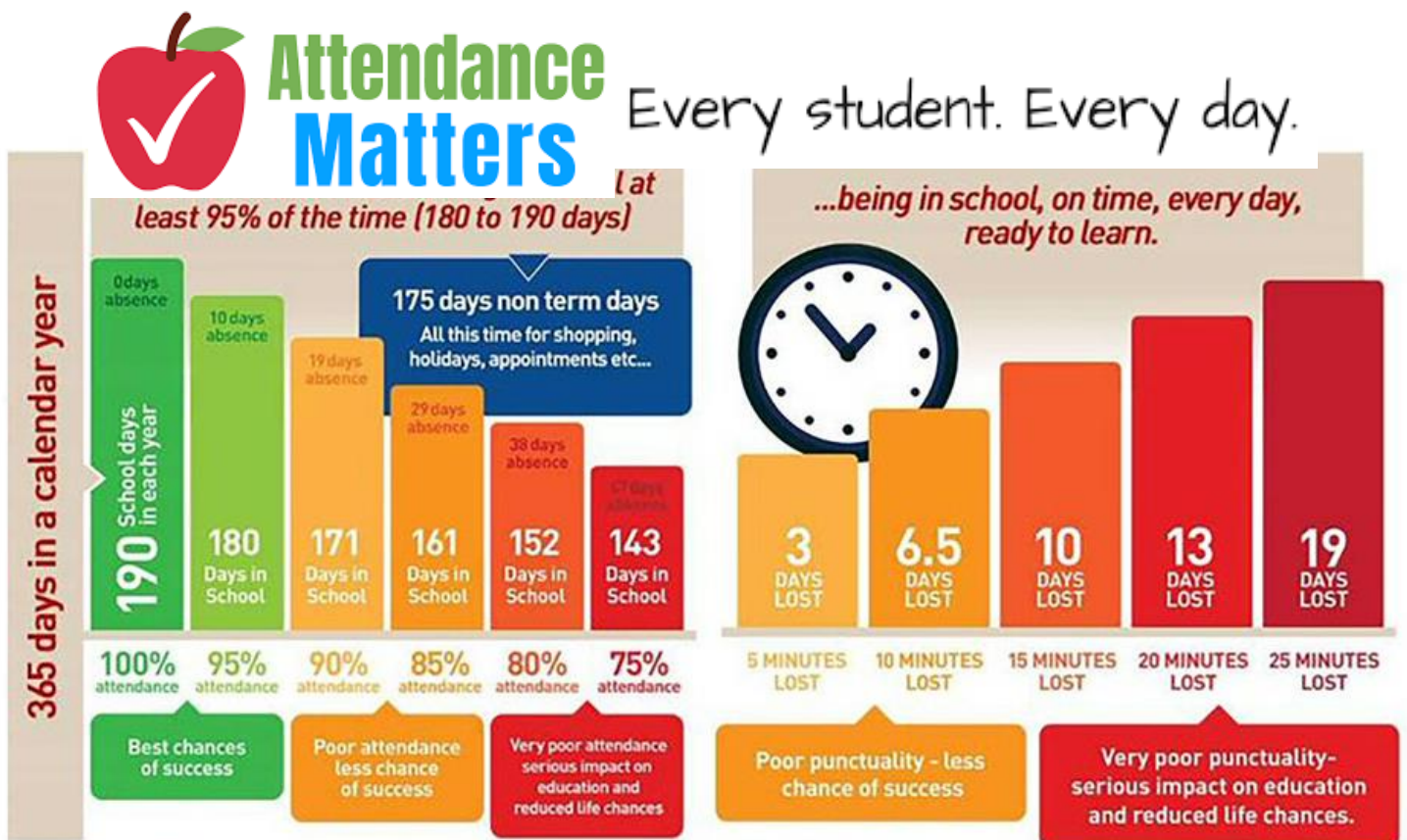


As we became a completely cashless school in January, many of you have already been using our My Child At School platform to pay for your child's toast, lunches, and school trips. If you have not yet needed to pay for any of these, you may need to in the future so it is important that you have set up your account, as we will not take payments in any other form.

In addition to making payments, we are in the process of setting up the use of this app to send out any letters/messages from school, and also receive messages in the school office from parents. Please do not send any messages for class teachers – it will strictly be used for administrative purposes (e.g. re: using the MCAS app, notifying us of your child's absence, alternative collection arrangements, etc).

Please enable the app to send you notifications in order to be updated when you receive a message from school. Please also ensure that the school office has the most up to date contact details for you, and that you inform us of any changes as soon as possible.

The platform is simple to use and is available on all smart mobile devices via their app stores. If you haven't set this up already, please come and see Mrs Addis in the school office or email us on mcas@reaside.uwmat.co.uk
