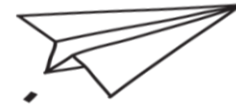

AT REASIDE, OUR ATTENDANCE TARGET IS 96%.

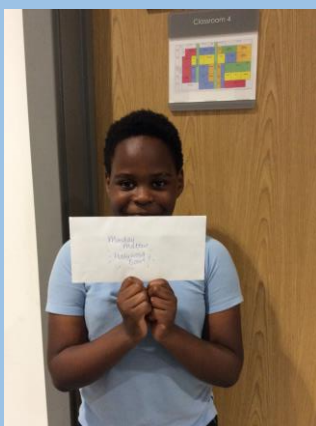
Please ensure you send your child to school every day. If they are unwell, and you are unsure as to whether they can come in, please do not hesitate to call the office who will advise.
