


Another thing that came out of the workshop that we want to share with you is the importance of:


- Thinking about an escape plan in your home should there be a fire.
- and making sure you've got working smoke detectors which are tested every week












Year 5 built a wooden prototype of a truss bridge this week and have evaluated it, stating which materials would be best to use and how they could make it stronger.
